Our mission is to bring environmental education, outdoor recreation, and cultural events to Ringwood and the surrounding areas. We are a volunteer-based, grassroots group and we welcome your membership, involvement and support as we continue to restore our buildings and grounds. We are pleased to host many scout activities, including merit badge programs, community service projects, and camping at our group campsite. We also offer rentals of our indoor and outdoor facilities for parties, classes, meetings, and corporate retreats.

We want to congratulate Iron Mountain Stage Company, our first full-fledged partner here at the Center, on their 3rd year of delightful and entertaining performances! We thank them for making The New Weis Center their home base. In addition to their major productions, Iron Mountain leads improv classes for our summer campers, and will be presenting a holiday show at The New Weis Center once again this December.
